First-year students are allotted double or triple sharing bedrooms depending on availability. Senior students are assigned single or double sharing rooms based on their age.

# FEE PAYMENT AND REFUND POLICY

## Admission Fee Payment

The students taking admission in any program of the university will have to pay admission fee semester wise and annually as applicable.

👉 **For semester system:** Fee payment dates:

- 👉 Complete semester fee has to be paid at the time of admission.
- 👉 For rest other semesters, complete fee has to be paid as per timeline given by the university.
- 👉 Examination fee has to be paid at the time of filling of online examination form during the semester.

👉 **For annual system:** Fee payment dates:

- 👉 Complete first year fee has to be paid at the time of admission.
- 👉 For rest other years, complete fee has to be paid as per timeline given by the university.
- 👉 Examination fee has to be paid at the time of filling of online examination form during the semester.

👉 There is no provision of fee payment in installment.

## Cancellation of Admission and Refund of Fee

- 👉 Ideally, cancellation of admission is not allowed however, in special case the same can be processed after the due approval of the Vice Chancellor.
- 👉 If admission cancellation is requested within 7-days of taking admission, a refund of fee after deduction of Rs. 5000/- will be done.
- 👉 If admission cancellation request is made after 7-days of taking admission, in that case NO FEE will be refunded.
- 👉 The above rule will not apply to admissions taken within 7-days of last date of admissions.

## Hostel Allotment and Fee Payment

- 👉 Hostel will be allotted at the time of taking admission/counselling in offline mode. Students have to pay one-time payment of annual hostel fee at the time of hostel allotment:
- 👉 For fresh admission only.
  - a) Rs. 65000/- per academic year (For Girls Hostel): This includes hostel fee & food.
  - b) Rs. 75000/- per academic year (For Boys Hostel): This includes hostel fee & food.
- 👉 Students already residing in the hostel have to pay the hostel fee every year in the month of July. Admissions to the hostel are to be renewed every academic year.
- 👉 10% Hostel rooms are reserved for international students. In case of no international students the same will be allotted to other students.
- 👉 Basic hostel facilities/amenities will be provided for a pleasant stay in the campus.

## Cancellation of Hostel and Fee Refund

- 👉 No cancellation of hostel is admissible during a academic year.
- 👉 If hostel cancellation is requested within 7-days of hostel allotment, a refund of hostel fee after deduction of Rs. 5000/- plus mess charges will be done.
- 👉 If hostel cancellation request is made after 7-days of hostel allotment, NO FEE will be refunded.

**Note: Admission to the hostel is not a right, but a privilege extended to the students.**

Q-2 : What is the last date for paying registration fee?

A-2 : The registration fee of Combined Entrance Test 2025-26 can be paid from 15th March 2025 to 30th April 2025 through Credit/Debit Card/Net Banking/UPI.

Q-3 : What is the registration fee for various categories when filling out the Combined Entrance Test 2025-26 application form?

A-3 : Candidates can apply for a minimum of ONE and a maximum of FIVE courses by paying the application fee of Rs. 1000/-.

Q-4 : What is the registration fee for reserve categories applicants?

A-4 : The application fee is Rs. 1000/-.

Q-5 : What is the date for Combined Entrance Test 2025-26 application correction window?

A-5 : Application Form Correction window will be open from 1st May 2025 till 5th May 2025. Candidates who had earlier filled in the Combined Entrance Test-2025-26 application form and committed some mistakes will get the opportunity to edit the registration form.

Q-6 : What is the miscellaneous information about eligibility criteria?

A-6 : For admission in the university through Combined Entrance Test 2025-26, the existing policies regarding quota, category, relaxations, reservations, qualifications, subject combinations, preferences etc. of the university shall be applicable. ## General Guidelines and Information for Admission

The following procedure shall be followed for the selection of the candidates in admission to various programmes.

1. The minimum eligibility and number of seats for the admission to various programmes will remain the same as per the information provided in the prospectus 2025-26. Kindly, visit university website for more details and updates.
2. Before filling out the Admission Application Form, the candidate is required to read the prospectus carefully. Candidates will have to submit their "Application Form" through online mode only (<https://www.mgug.ac.in>) for admission to various programmes, and a printout of the submitted application form and fee receipt, should be saved for the future communication.
3. If, during the entrance processes/ admission, the admission committee finds any discrepancy, the admission form may be rejected or an email may be sent to the candidate for resubmission of the admission form/ documents within a given period of time.



4. The merit lists will be displayed on the university website.
5. The merit list will be prepared on the basis of performances of the candidates in the combined entrance test. However, the applicant will responsible to ensure that they fulfil the eligibility criteria for the programmes.
6. The candidate in the merit list, will have to appear for the counselling and document verification, and thereof candidates are directed to submit two sets of photocopies of related documents with two recent passport size photographs to the admission cell during counselling. After document verification candidate will have to deposit the programme fee online (Semester/ year wise) at the time of counselling, if fail to do so then his/her admission will be considered cancelled and the seat shall be offered to the next candidate from the merit order.
7. If, the admission cell is not fully satisfied with the academic credential /character, they may deny to admit the candidate in any programme in the University.
8. If the academic qualification/ any information related to admission found incorrect/ forged in future, then admission will be cancelled and no fee will be paid back.
9. All Admissions are provisional and subjected to document verification by the competent authority at any time during the programme.
10. No plea and ignorance of the rules and regulations and other provisions related to admission will be entertained.
11. The rules related to anti-ragging and students' behaviour in the campus and in the hostels as framed by the University will be applicable to and binding on all newly admitted students up to their program completion.

### **Combined Entrance Test (MGUG 2025-26)**

- I. Entrance Test will comprise of 100 questions (01 mark each) of 2 hours duration, unless otherwise mentioned and will consist of multiple-choice questions (questions with one correct answer). There will be no negative marking. The details/instructions for attempting the question paper will be given in the booklet/question paper at the time of Entrance Test.
- II. The entrance examination pattern for the Combined Entrance Test will be consistent across all programmes:
  - \* 60% of the questions will be based on the syllabus of the first preference opted programme.

- \* 20% of the questions will be covered from General studies, Current Affairs, Aptitude and Reasoning.
  - \* 20% of the questions will be based on the Indian Knowledge System, especially focusing on the epics of Ramayan and Mahabharat.
- III. The candidate will have to report at the concerned examination centre at least half an hour before the commencement of the Combined Entrance Test. The entrance tests will be held as per schedule given in the prospectus/notification available on the university website. However, the university have right to change the schedule of entrance test, date of declaration of the result, for such updates, candidates are requested to visit university website (<https://www.mgug.ac.in>) frequently.
  - IV. If a candidate found involved in using any unfair means during the Combined Entrance Test, his/her candidature shall be cancelled immediately.
  - V. There shall be no provision for re-evaluation/rechecking of the answer sheet of the Combined Entrance Test 2025-26.
